

PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

WALK-IN REGISTRATION

Register in person at the Brick Township Recreation Office located in the Civic Plaza, 270 Chambers Bridge Road. Office hours are 7:30am - 4:00pm, Monday through Friday. The office accepts cash, check or money order made payable to the Township of Brick and Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover Credit Cards.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

The Recreation Department is pleased to offer online registration for most programs and events.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Enrollment is limited to Brick Township residents, children of Brick Township taxpayers or those who receive regular daily care from a relative who is a Brick Township resident.
- A driver's license, tax bill, utility bill or lease with a Brick Township address may be required to complete registration.
- A birth certificate may be required for children ages 6 and under.
- All programs require a minimum enrollment.
- All programs, dates and fees listed in this brochure are subject to change.

REFUND POLICY

- Full refunds will be given in the event that the Recreation Department cancels a program or if there is a medical reason. A doctor's note may be required.
- Refunds will only be issued up to two weeks prior to the start of the program.
- Convenience fees for using credit cards are **NON-REFUNDABLE**.
- The Recreation Department Director reserves the right to adjust the refund policy.

Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover cards are accepted. There is a convenience fee for using credit cards online and in person. The convenience fee is \$1.95 for transactions under \$100 and 2.5% of the transaction total for \$100 and over.

Please note: Beach Badges cannot be purchased online.

FACILITY RENTAL INFORMATION

Brick Township has several municipal facilities available for rental for private purposes. Established fees and insurance requirements apply to all rentals. These facilities include:

Windward Beach Park 265 Princeton Avenue - located on the Metedeconk River, Windward Beach Park has three areas that can be rented by the public for exclusive use. These are the bandshell area, the gazebo and the picnic area.

Drum Point Sports Complex 303 Drum Point Road - located on Drum Point Road adjacent to Drum Point Elementary and Emma Havens Young Schools, the facility has numerous athletic fields, a walking/jogging trail, fitness stations, restrooms and lighting.

Traders Cove Marina and Park - located at 40 Mantoloking Road has a gazebo and picnic areas that can be rented for various functions.

Civic Plaza - located at 270 Chambers Bridge Road, the facility has restrooms and an all purpose room. Please note, this facility is available to non-profit organizations only,

Brick Township operates three ocean beaches and one riverfront beach at Windward Beach Park. All beaches are staffed with lifeguards 7 days a week between June 13 and Labor Day. They are open weekends from Memorial Day Weekend - June 12. Beach hours of operation are 8:45am - 4:45pm. Beach badges are required for access to all beaches.

BRICK BEACH I - 310 Route 35 North

While on Route 35 South look for the Pioneer Fire Hose building which will be on your left hand side, (approximately 1-2 miles past Mantoloking Rd.) Take the next left on Sea Breeze Way and turn left on Route 35 North. The parking lot for Brick Beach One is on your right. Amenities include outdoor shower heads, concessions, parking, restrooms.

BRICK BEACH II - 354 Route 35 North

There are no concessions, bathrooms or parking at Beach II. To access Brick Beach II, park at either Brick Beach I or III and walk on the beach to Brick Beach II. PLEASE NOTE: There will be no access to Brick Beach II from Route 35 this summer; to access this beach, you must walk along the ocean from Beach I or Beach III.

BRICK BEACH III - 440 Route 35 North

While on Route 35 South look for "Bayside Park" which will be on your right hand side, (approximately 2-3 miles past Mantoloking Rd.) Directly across from Bayside Park on 35 North is the parking lot for Brick Beach III. Brick Beach III has restrooms, concession and parking lot. Brick Beach III is the southernmost Brick Beach.

WINDWARD BEACH PARK 265 Princeton Avenue

Amenities include parking, playgrounds, volleyball nets, restrooms, fishing and crabbing piers, bocce courts, horseshoe pits, gazebo and picnic areas.

SENIOR BEACH BADGES

Seniors who will be age 65 by September 1, 2016 may receive a free daily wristband for access to Brick Township's beaches. Each individual requesting a wristband must provide proof of age (driver's license, birth certificate, county ID card). Senior wristbands are available at Brick Beach I, Brick Beach III and Windward Beach - not in the Brick Recreation Offices. Additionally, residents who will be age 65 by September 1, 2016 may purchase a Senior discount season parking permit for \$15. Parking permits may be purchased at Beach I, Beach III and the Recreation Office.

SURF CHAIRS

Individuals with disabilities have the opportunity to reserve a specially designed wheel chair that will provide easy access to Beach I, Beach III and Windward Beach. Call 732-262-1184 for information or to reserve a chair on a first come first serve basis.

2017 GIRLS SOFTBALL LEAGUE

Brick girls in grades 3 - 9

Registration fee includes 12 game season, playoffs, t-shirt and award for each player. Games held on weekday evenings from mid-May through mid-June.

Fee: \$65

Location: Drum Point Sports Complex.

Registration held from 1/2 - 2/24

Returning 5th and 7th grade girls must try out along with any girls who have not played previously. All children will be placed on a team and will be guaranteed to play.

BRICK BARRACUDA SWIM TEAM 2016

Brick boys and girls ages 5 - 14

This is the 23rd Season of the Barracudas Swim Team. The team competes throughout Ocean and Monmouth Counties. The program consists of age-appropriate practices, continuous swimming and participation in meets. All swimmers must meet minimum requirements or they will be referred to an instruction program.

REQUIREMENTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

5 and 6 year olds:	Continuous 25 yard sets of unassisted freestyle and alternating backstroke and kick board drills.
7 and 8 year olds:	Continuous 100 yard sets
9 and 10 year olds:	Continuous 150 yard sets
11 and 12 year olds:	Continuous 200-300 yard sets
13 and 14 year olds:	Continuous 500 yard sets
Sets for ages 7 - 14 are comprised of alternating freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, butterfly and related drills.	

Fee: \$105




