- 5) Issuance of a special events permit does not relieve the applicant from complying with permits required under other New Jersey statues or municipal ordinances including, but not limited to, construction permits required under the Uniform Construction Code NJAC 5:23 or permits required under the Uniform Fire Code N.J.A.C. 5:70.

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ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, TO EXTEND THE RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING IN THE PLAYGROUND PARKING LOT AT TRADERS COVE THROUGH THE SUMMER MONTHS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 288 of the Township Code of the Township of Brick entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" is hereby amended in Section 288-35, to delete the current section entitled "Schedule V: Time Limit Parking" and to replace it with the following:

§288-35. Schedule V: Time Limit Parking.

In accordance with the provisions of §288-10, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time shown upon any of the following streets or parts of streets or parking lots:
