RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, URGING LEGISLATORS TO TAKE ACTION TO OPPOSE AND SEEK CHANGES TO THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM "NFIP"

WHEREAS, floods are one of the most common and most destructive natural disasters in the United States

WHEREAS, the National Flood Insurance Act authorizes a National Flood Insurance program ("NFIP")

WHEREAS, the NFIP is a program created by Congress to mitigate future flood losses across the United States and to further provide access to affordable flood insurance protection for property owners; and

WHEREAS, the NFIP is designed to provide an insurance alternative to disaster assistance to meet the increasing costs of repairing damage to buildings and their contents caused by floods; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey is third amongst states in total value of claims paid and fourth in the number of NFIP policies enforced; and

WHEREAS, five hundred and fifty-two communities in New Jersey participate as members of the NFIP; and

WHEREAS, the NFIP maintains a significant role in providing financial protection against flood events to New Jersey property owners; and

WHEREAS, the NFIP is set to expire on September 30, 2019, and

WHEREAS, on June 12 the House Financial Services Committee unanimously passed legislation to reauthorize and reform the NFIP, known as H.R. 3167; and

WHEREAS, the proposed reauthorization provides for the following unacceptable terms: the increase of rates to primary homeowners up to 18% annually until they reach their actuary rates (every 4 years premiums may double); the increase of rates to secondary homeowners up to 25% annually until they reach their actuary rate (every 3 years premiums may double); the increase to risk/premiums for communities that have high construction/replacement costs; the implementation of risk rating 2.0 mapping which results in higher premiums the closer you live to water; and an increase to the cost of compliance limits that is still insufficient to meet actual numbers.

WHEREAS, Brick Township Community Rating System is at a Class 6, which provides a 20% discount to those insured through the NFIP. Brick Township staff has worked tirelessly to get the Town into this program to ensure a continued, focused effort on flood proofing and flood protective measure to increase safety and to plan strategically. Based upon how well Brick Township complies with NFIP regulations and guidelines, our citizens experience a discount on their flood insurance premiums. As a Class 6, our residents experience a 20% discount to those insured through the NFIP.

WHEREAS, by the Township has worked hard to make flood insurance affordable for our residents and all of our hard work would be lost if this new rate schedule is approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey that the reauthorize and reform the NFIP is unacceptable to the Township of Brick.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Financial Services Committee should rescind the reform or exclude communities like Brick who are active participants in the CRS program,
