Forms of solicitation are on file at the Brick Township **Building Department**, 401 Chambers Bridge Rd. Brick, NJ 08723, (732) 262-1039 and may be obtained upon request. Bidders are required to comply with the discrimination and affirmative action requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 to 38 as amended and to execute the Affirmative Action Affidavit and to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 regarding the submission of a list of all stockholders or partners owning more than 10% stock or interest in their corporation or partnership and to execute the Ownership Disclosure Certificate. Bidders are also required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 which states each bidder (contractor and subcontractors) are required to submit proof of business registration. **DUNS #** and proof of registration on www.sam.gov must be submitted with bid.

Bids will be made on the Proposal Form in the manner designated therein as instructed by the specifications. Each solicitation must be enclosed in a sealed envelope clearly marked with the PROJECT Number on each envelope. Submit bids to the **TOWNSHIP CLERK'S OFFICE**
