

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick previously awarded a contract to Shore Top Construction Corp., 390 Toms River Road, Jackson, NJ 08527 on February 26, 2019 for the project known as "Drainage Improvements to Baywood" for a total contract price in the amount of \$351,612.50; and

WHEREAS, Shore Top Construction Corp. has completed the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Engineer has inspected the work and deemed the work to be complete; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.3 the Township Engineer has recommended the approval of Close-Out Change Order #1 decreasing the contract by (\$34,152.50) from \$351,612.50 to \$317,460.00 as a result of final as-built quantities; and

WHEREAS, the approval of this Close-Out Change Order #1 will result in the return of the performance bond posted for this project. Shore Top Construction Corp. has provided maintenance bond, which will run for a period of two (2) years; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Attorney has reviewed the maintenance bond and deemed same to be acceptable; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now the desire of this Township Council to act upon the Township Engineer's recommendation and to approve said Close-Out Change Order #1.

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#### **ORDINANCE**

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE DEDICATION OF A PORTION OF BLOCK 702, LOTS 30 AND 31 TO THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-39(a)

**WHEREAS**, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-1 *et seq.* (the "Redevelopment Law") authorizes municipalities to determine whether certain parcels of land located therein constitute areas in need of redevelopment and to create redevelopment plans which provide development controls for any area so designated; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Redevelopment Law, on July 24, 2007, the Council (the "Council") of the Township of Brick, New Jersey (the "Township"), by resolution, designated certain properties in the Township known as Metedeconk Village as an area in need of redevelopment in accordance with the Redevelopment Law, which properties included certain lots now known as Block 702, Lots 30 and 31 on the tax map of the Township (the "Redevelopment Area"); and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2008, the Council adopted Ordinance 27-08 adopting the Metedeconk Village Redevelopment Plan which, as amended, sets forth the plan for the redevelopment of the Redevelopment Area; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12-4, the Township has determined to act as the "redevelopment entity" (as such term is defined at *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-3 of the Redevelopment Law) for the Redevelopment Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Redevelopment Law authorizes the redevelopment entity to arrange or contract for the planning, construction or undertaking of any development project or redevelopment work in an area designated as an "area in need of redevelopment" pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-8; and

WHEREAS, to further the redevelopment of the Redevelopment Area, the Township determined to subdivide the Redevelopment Area into two (2) lots; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township owns that portion of the Redevelopment Area identified on the official tax maps of the Township as a portion of Block 702, Lots 30 and 31 and described in **Exhibit A**, attached hereto, (the "**Property**"); and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2019, the Ocean County Planning Board finally approved the minor subdivision for a lot line adjustment at the intersection of Brick Boulevard and Route 70 located in the Redevelopment Area (the "Intersection") contingent upon the Township submitting a deed to Ocean County, New Jersey (the "County") for the Property; and

**WHEREAS**, as per the "Jurisdictional Map for Route 70 and Brick Boulevard", the County maintains jurisdiction over the jughandle at the Intersection (the "Jughandle"); and

WHEREAS, the Property consists of 0.564 acres along the Jughandle; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-39(a), the Township desires to dedicate the Property to the County to further the redevelopment of the Redevelopment Area.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

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- **Section 2**. The Township, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-39(a), approves the dedication of the Property from the Township to the County.
- **Section 3**. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate this Ordinance, including the deed for the Property attached hereto as **Exhibit B**, subject to the review and approval by the Township counsel or redevelopment counsel.
- **Section 4**. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- , **Section 5**. A copy of this Ordinance shall be available for public inspection at the offices of the Township Clerk.
  - **Section 6**. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with applicable law.
