RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING EXTENSION OF CONTRACT FOR ELECTRICAL SUPPLY SERVICES WITH AGGRESSIVE ENERGY, LLC

WHEREAS, the Township previously conducted an auction through its energy consultant, Concord Energy, for the Township's lighting accounts and streetlight accounts, which resulted in a contract with Aggressive Energy, LLC that expires on June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the energy consultant has requested and received renewal pricing from Aggressive Energy, LLC for an extension of the contract for those same electrical supply services through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the renewal pricing reflects a 21% savings for general electrical accounts and a 10% savings for streetlight accounts; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council desires to authorize the Mayor to extend the contract for electrical supply services with Aggressive Energy for an additional 18 months, to expire on December 31, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Township hereby extends the contract with Aggressive Energy, LLC for Electrical Supply Services as per the following rates:

General Service \$0.07263 kWh
Lighting \$0.05105 kWh

2. The term of the extension of contract shall be July 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021, an extension of eighteen (18) months total.

WHEREAS, the Municipality wishes to enter into an Agreement with the County for the purpose of setting forth the terms and conditions regarding the assignment of police officers employed by the Municipality to the Prosecutor's Program.

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority has proposed toll hikes affecting the Garden State Parkway and the New Jersey Turnpike; and

WHEREAS, Brick Township residents, many of whom regularly commute to work, rely heavily on the Garden State Parkway to travel both locally and across the State; and

WHEREAS, in 2016, 15,992 Brick Township residents – 44% of the workforce over the age of 16 – worked outside Ocean County and 6,192 Brick Township residents – 17% of the work force – commuted over 60 minutes to work; and

WHEREAS, it is safe to assume that the majority of these commuters traveled on the Garden State Parkway at some point during that commute; and

WHEREAS, the toll increase proposed by the New Jersey Turnpike Authority will place an extra burden on these residents and it is burden that will not be felt by communities whose residents are not so reliant on the Garden State Parkway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

1. The Township Council joins Mayor John G. Ducey in urging Governor Phil Murphy and the New Jersey Turnpike Authority to reconsider any plan that increases tolls on the Garden State Parkway and the New Jersey Turnpike.

- 1) All fire lanes and fire access must remain open and accessible at all times.
- 2) A permit for the tent shall be obtained from the Bureau of Fire Safety for the tent at least ten (10) days prior to the event. A certificate of flame resistance should be included for tent with the application.
- 3) The Township Council desires to waive the \$100.00 application fee for this event.
- 4) All participants will not violate the social distancing restrictions.
- 5) The applicant will provide an adequate number of sanitary facilities (bathrooms) for the number of persons present. If temporary portable facilities are utilized at least one portable facility will be handicap accessible. All temporary facilities shall be serviced to maintain them in a sanitary condition.
- 6) Issuance of a special events permit does not relieve the applicant from complying with permits required under other New Jersey statues or municipal ordinances including, but not limited to, construction permits required under the Uniform Construction Code NJAC 5:23 or permits required under the Uniform Fire Code N.J.A.C. 5:70.
- 7) Contingent upon Approval by Police Department and Bureau of Fire Safety.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING AN AMENDED RATE OF INTEREST FOR DELINQUENT PAYMENT OF PROPERTY TAXES DUE ON MAY 1, 2020

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-67 permits the governing body of each municipality to fix the rate of interest to be charged for nonpayment of taxes or assessments subject to any abatement or discount for the late payment of taxes as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the next quarterly payment of property taxes in the Township is due on May 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council, in recognition of the economic hardship suffered by some residents and businesses due to the Covid-19 pandemic, desire to provide some temporary relief from interest charged for the delinquent payment of property taxes for the next quarterly payment; and

WHEREAS, the reduction of the interest rate for delinquent taxes to zero percent for the month of May 2020 shall effectively provide a 30-day grace period to property owners for a delinquent second quarter tax payment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The rate of interest for delinquent property taxes that are due on May 1, 2020 shall be set at Zero Percent (0%) for the period May 1, 2020 through May 31, 2020.
2. As of June 1, 2020, the rate shall revert to the normal interest rates charged by the Township for delinquent property taxes.
3. A notice of this action shall be printed once in the official newspapers of the Township of Brick.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Office of the Tax Collector.

ORDINANCE

CALENDAR YEAR 2020 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Brick in the County of Ocean finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2020 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Council hereby determines that a 3.5 % increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$2,788,002.53 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Township Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Brick, in the County of Ocean, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2020 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Brick shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 1.0%, bringing the percentage to 3.5% amounting to a \$796,572.15 increase, bringing the total to \$2,788,002.53 and that the CY 2020 municipal budget for the Township of Brick be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.
