OBTAINING A MARRIAGE LICENSE

WHERE TO APPLY

If the ceremony is to take place in New Jersey, the couple must apply in the municipality where either Partner legally resides. If they both reside outside of New Jersey, they must apply in the municipality where the ceremony will occur.

For Brick Township Residents:

Brick Township Clerk/Registrar Office, Monday through Friday, by **Appointment Only**. Appointments are scheduled between 9:00am - 11:00am and 2:00pm -3:00pm. Call (732) 262-1001 to schedule your appointment.

WHEN/HOW TO APPLY

Approximately 1-2 weeks prior to the Ceremony:

1. Applicants should print out the application from our website: www.bricktownship.net, under the Office of the Township Clerk and Vital Statistics.
2. Complete the application in its entirety, but do not sign.
3. Email the application to the Township Clerk at clerk@twp.brick.nj.us and the Assistant Township Clerk at jarney@twp.brick.nj.us, along with copies of both of your IDs and your witness's ID.
If your ID does not contain your Brick Township address, a separate Proof of Residency will be required.
4. Once the Clerk reviews the application she will contact you with any questions and schedule an Appointment for both of you and your witness to come in, sign the application, pay the \$28.00 fee and pick up your license (Due to COVID-19 the mandatory 72 hour waiting period has been waived).

After the license is issued to you, the marriage license may be used in the State of New Jersey for ninety (90) days, after which time the license expires.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

By Appointment Only

Present at application time –

- 1.) Partner
- 2.) Partner
- 3.) One Witness with Proper Identification - Must be 18 Years of Age or Older and Speaks English.

Required Documents:

- 1.) Driver's License, Passport **or** State/Federal ID
- 2.) Proof of Residency - such as a driver's license, utility bill, lease, tax return, etc
- 3.) \$28.00 Exact Change, Check or Charge (Visa / Mastercard / Discover)

Requested Documents:

- 1.) Birth Certificates
- 2.) If Previously Married: Final Divorce Decree, Death Certificate or Civil Union Certificate

All documents must be English Translated if in a foreign language.

Must Know-

- 1.) Date of Marriage
- 2.) Name and Address of Person Performing the Marriage (Rev., Pastor, Judge, Mayor, etc.)
- 3.) Both Partners Social Security Numbers
- 4.) Both Parents Birth Places (State only / If born outside of the U.S. – Country only)
- 5.) Both Mother's Maiden Name
- 6.) If Divorced - Exact Date of Divorce & County / State in which filed
- 7.) If Widowed – Exact Date of Death of Spouse & Town/State where they passed away
- 8.) If Civil Union – Exact Date of Union & Town / State in which performed

Blood Tests are No Longer Required to Obtain a Marriage License in NJ
