ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, TO LOWER THE SPEED LIMIT ON THE EASTERN END OF PRINCETON AVENUE

WHEREAS, several residents requested a speed limit study be conducted along Princeton Avenue, which is a County roadway; and

WHEREAS, the Ocean County Engineer conducted two speed surveys, and concluded that the collected data does not support a reduction from the current 40 mph speed limit on Princeton Avenue to the west of Beaver Dam Road, but supports a reduction in the speed limit to the east of Beaver Dam Road to 25 mph; and

WHEREAS, the Township's Public Safety Committee has reviewed the conclusions of the County and recommends the adoption of an ordinance to reduce the speed limit on Princeton Avenue to the east of Beaver Dam Road to 25 mph; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to adopt a concurring County Resolution and to install and maintain the required signage to indicate the speed limits;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 288 of the Township Code of the Township of Brick entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" is hereby amended in Section 288-50, entitled "Schedule XX: Speed Limits," to add the following street, in an appropriate alphabetical location, to the schedule of streets with speed limits:

§288-50. Schedule XX: Speed Limits.

In accordance with the provisions of § 288-25, speed limits are hereby established on the following described streets or parts thereof:

Name of Street	(mph)	Location
Princeton Avenue	25	Between Beaver Dam Road and the easternmost end of Princeton Avenue

- **SECTION 2.** Upon the effective date of this Ordinance, the County of Ocean has indicated that it will install and maintain the required signage to give notice of the speed limit on the portion of the roadway described herein.
- **SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof
- **SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
