CLOSE OUT CHANGE ORDER #1

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick previously awarded a contract to Meco, Inc., P.O. Box 536, Clarksburg, NJ 08510 on October 13, 2020 for the project known as "Roadway Improvements to Parkway Pines" for a total contract price in the amount of \$301,579.25; and

WHEREAS, Meco, Inc. has completed the project; and

WHEREAS, the consulting engineer, CME Associates, has inspected the work and deemed the work to be complete; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.3 the consulting engineer has recommended the approval of Close-Out Change Order #1 increasing the contract by \$11,569.12 from \$301,579.25 to \$313,148.37 as a result of final as-built quantities; and

WHEREAS, the approval of this Close-Out Change Order #1 will result in the return of the performance bond posted for this project. Contractor has provided maintenance bond, which will run for a period of two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, the Township Attorney has reviewed the maintenance bond and deemed same to be acceptable; and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of this Township Council to act upon the consulting engineer's recommendation and to approve said Close-Out Change Order #1.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO "OPT IN" TO THE CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT OF OPIOID CLAIMS AGAINST VARIOUS PHARMACEUTICAL COMPANIES

WHEREAS, the Township joined a class action lawsuit in September 2019 against numerous pharmaceutical companies to assert claims related to improperly promoting the use of opioids to the public, and for the costs the Township and other governments incurred in responding to the "opioid crisis" created thereby, entitled National Prescription Opiate Litigation bearing Case No. 1:17-md-2804 (N.D. Ohio) (the "Class Action"); and

WHEREAS, the Township has received formal notice from the State of New Jersey Office of Attorney General (the "NJAG") concerning two proposed national settlements of the Class Action (the "Settlements") reached between all states and local political subdivisions and the three largest pharmaceutical distributors of opioid products, McKesson, Cardinal Health and Amerisource Bergen (collectively, "Distributors") and one manufacturer, Janssen Pharmaceuticals, Inc., and its parent company Johnson & Johnson (collectively, "Janssen"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Settlements include the following terms: "the Distributors to pay up to \$21 billion over 18 years and Janssen to pay up to \$5 billion over no more than 9 years, for a total of \$26 billion (the "Settlement Amount"). Approximately \$22.7 billion of the Settlement Amount are payable to state and local subdivisions, with at least 85% to be used to remediate and abate the impacts of the opioid crisis. The Settlements also contain injunctive relief provisions governing the opioid marketing, sale and distribution practices at the heart of the states' and subdivisions' lawsuits and further require the Distributors to implement additional safeguards to prevent diversion of prescription opioids;" and

WHEREAS, the manner in which settlements funds are to be allocated to the municipal participants, including the Township, has not yet been determined; and

WHEREAS, each municipality's share in the settlement funds would ultimately depend on population and the effects of the opioid epidemic on each community; and

WHEREAS, the Township must decide whether to "opt in" to the Settlements, meaning be a part of this settlement (and agree to any allocation later decided), or "opt out", meaning not be a part of this settlement and pursue its own litigation against the Distributors and Janssen at its own cost; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Township to authorize an "opt in" to the aforementioned settlements against the Distributors and Janssen because the "opt in" option is more likely to benefit the public interest of the Township and its taxpayers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Mayor and Township Attorney are authorized to execute any documentation necessary for the Township to "opt in" to the aforementioned Settlements of the Class Action.

Authorizing the Adoption of the Repetitive Loss Area Analysis

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick participates in the National Flood Insurance Program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick has applied for the 5-Year Cycle Review for the National Flood Insurance Program's Community Rating System (CRS);

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick received a Class 6 rating that provides a 20% reduction in flood insurance premiums, and

WHEREAS, in 2017, the Township produced a Repetitive Loss Area Analysis and has completed an update to this analysis in compliance with CRS Element 512 b. for Floodplain Management Planning; and

WHEREAS, since participating in the CRS program, the Township of Brick has made great strides in mitigating properties and has reported the mitigation of 38 of the 92 Repetitive Loss Properties and has reduced the amount of Repetitive Loss Areas from 27 areas to 20 areas; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick Floodplain Management Committee worked diligently with Township officials and staff to hold three public hearings, eight working meetings, and advised the public of the analysis and requested their input on the hazards and recommended actions through a series of surveys that were advertised via social media and sent to residents in the Repetitive Loss Areas via mail. Residents were informed the analysis was being conducted, and how to obtain the draft report through the Land Use & Planning Office and online; and

WHEREAS, agencies or organizations that may have plans or studies that could affect the cause or impacts of flooding were contacted and advised of the analysis; and

WHEREAS, data was collected on each building in the Repetitive Loss Areas, alternative approaches to property protection and drainage features was studied and findings for each Repetitive Loss Area was provide and summarized; and

WHEREAS, the Repetitive Loss Area Analysis is intended to reduce private and public property damages due to future floods through providing more specific guidance on how to reduce damage from repetitive flooding than a community-wide floodplain management or hazard mitigation plan; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has had an opportunity to review the Repetitive Loss Area Analysis and Appendices A through E, and finds that it is in the best interest of the Township of Brick to adopt the Plan in order to meet the CRS Program requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body for the Township of Brick that: The 2021 Township of Brick Repetitive Loss Area Analysis is hereby adopted and the officials of the Township of Brick are authorized to evaluate the report annually in compliance with the FEMA NFIP CRS Program guidelines.
