Through our Trap-Neuter-Return program, feral cats are:

- Spayed or Neutered
- Vaccinated for Rabies
- Ear-tipped (visual identifier of a sterilized feral cat)

Feral cats are the offspring of abandoned domestic cats, who very quickly adapt to a life in the wild. Except in rare circumstances, they cannot be tamed to live indoors as pets.

Abandonment of unaltered pets is a problem caused by humans and should be solved by humans using a humane methodology.

The Brick Township TNR Program exists to help feral cat colony caretakers spay, neuter and vaccinate their feral cats. Managed, sterile colonies stop reproducing, helping to halt the explosive birth rate and the number of kittens born in the wild.

Practices in Europe for over 30 years and in the United States for nearly 20, Trap/Neuter/Return has proven more effective in controlling feral cat populations than trap and kill programs.

Populations of feral cats have been reduced by as much as 50% in many regions of the United States that practice TNR.
