NEW BUSINESS

Master Plan Workshop -Presenter: Tara Paxton

Sandy funds passed through the Dept. of Community Affairs (DCA) to Municipalities for Post Sandy planning, this resulted in 11 grant plans. The plans will be used for the Township to get into the Community Rating System (CRS). Capital Improvement plan will be updated. Master Plan update will be presented at March 30, 2016 meeting. Four Neighborhood plans; Princeton-Midstreams, Cherry Quay-Bay Harbor, Shore Acres and Brick Barrier Island Beaches, examined for the effects of Sandy. Meetings were held with the neighborhoods and feedback was given on signs, landscaping and sidewalks. The Floodplain Management Plan will also be adopted, which is the main component of

the CRS points system. The Hazard Mitigation Plan captures the summary of flood risk and is the framework that supports the Land Use Grant program for generators, flood warning alert plan in frequently flooded areas. The Green Building and Sustainability Plan will also be adopted that identifies recommendations for the Township to adopt policies that make it more environmentally efficient. The Township received a Bronze Certification for Green Building and Sustainable Jersey.
