SECTION 2 PLAN ADOPTION

This section contains information regarding adoption of the Township's Flood Management Plan (FMP) by the Township of Brick's governing body (CRS Step 9).

2.1 PLAN ADOPTION BY LOCAL GOVERNING BODY

Adoption by the local governing body demonstrates the commitment of the Township to fulfill the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in the Plan. Adoption legitimizes the Plan and authorizes responsible agencies to execute their responsibilities. In order for the Plan to be approved, the Township's governing body must adopt the Plan before its submission for application to the CRS program. The Township Council adopted the plan on XXXX. The Township of Brick will formally adopt the plan. A sample resolution to be used by the Township is provided on the following page in Section 2, and a copy of the resolution is provided in Figure 2-1.

A **RESOLUTION** approving and adopting the Township of Brick Flood Management Plan.

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick participates in the National Flood Insurance Program; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick seeks to apply for and participate in the National Flood Insurance Program's Community Rating System (CRS);

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick currently is rated as a Class 10 community in the CRS program, which results in a 0% reduction in flood insurance premiums for property owners located in the Township's floodplains; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick qualifies for a Class X rating, which provides a XX% reduction in flood insurance premiums, but is unable to attain it without developing a Flood Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Flood Management Plan meets the CRS program prerequisites for an improved rating over Class 10 and entry into the Community Rating System; and

WHEREAS, the Flood Management Plan is intended to reduce private and public property damages due to future floods; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has had an opportunity to review the Flood Management Plan, and finds that it is in the best interest of the Township of Brick to adopt the Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body for the Township of Brick that:

- The 2015 Township of Brick Flood Management Plan is hereby adopted as the official Flood Management Plan of the Township, and





- The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the 2015 Township of Brick Flood Management Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
