CLOSE OUT CHANGE ORDER #1

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick previously awarded a contract to Captain Construction, Inc., 104 George Street, South River, NJ 08882 on January 19, 2021 for the project known as "Isolated Drainage & Roadway Improvements" for a total contract price in the amount of \$378,230.00; and

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 145-6 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR THE WAIVER OF FEES FOR CONSTRUCTION TO PROMOTE THE RENOVATION OF EXISTING VACANT COMMERCIAL STRUCTURES

WHEREAS, as part of its ongoing efforts to rehabilitate existing commercial structures and storefronts in the Township of Brick, the Township Council, in September 2015, created Chapter 145-6 of the Township Code entitled "Waiver of Fees for Construction to Promote the Renovation of Existing Vacant Commercial Structures"; and

WHEREAS, by providing for the waiver of fees for construction projects undertaken to renovate existing vacant commercial properties, the Township Council sought to encourage private property owners and their tenants, to undertake such projects to promote business and development within the Township of Brick; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council have determined that the waiver of fees has encouraged property owners and prospective business owners to rehabilitate empty storefront locations and is an effective tool in the effort to rehabilitate vacant commercial structures, including empty storefronts; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council subsequently, by duly adopted Ordinance, extended the waiver of fees in Chapter 145-6 to December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council now desires to extend the deadline for the waiver of fees from its current end date of December 31, 2020 to December 31, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Township Code of the Township of Brick is hereby amended and supplemented in Chapter 145-6, entitled "Waiver of Fees for Construction to Promote Renovation of Existing Vacant Commercial Structures," which amended Chapter 145-6 shall now read in relevant part as follows:

§ 145-6. Waiver of fees for construction to promote renovation of existing vacant commercial structures.

D. This ordinance shall expire on December 31, 2022 unless extended by the Township Council of the Township of Brick.

SECTION 2. Any provision of Chapter 145-6 not specifically amended herein shall remain the same.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

ARTICLE II Illicit Storm Sewer Connections

§ 396-15. Purpose

The purpose of this article is to prohibit illicit connections to the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the Township of Brick, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply.

§396-16. Definitions

For the purposes of this article, the following terms, phrases, words and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this article clearly demonstrates a different meaning. The definitions below are the same as or based on corresponding definitions in the New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination-System (NJPDES) rules at N.J.A.C. 7:14A-I.2.

DOMESTIC SEWAGE - Waste and wastewater from humans or householdoperations.

ILLICIT CONNECTION - Any physical or nonphysical connection that discharges.domestic sewage, on-contact cooling water, process wastewater, or other industrial waste (other than stormwater) to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Township of Brick, unless that discharge is authorized under a NJPDES permit other than the Tier A municipal stormwater general permit (NJPDES Permit Number NJOO 141852). Nonphysical connections may include, but are not limited to, leaks, flows, or overflows into the municipal separate storm sewersystem.

INDUSTRIAL WASTE - Nondomestic waste, including, but not limited to thosepollutants regulated under Section 307(a), (b), or (c) of the Federal Clean Water Act [33 U.S.C. §1317(a), (b), or (c)].

MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) - A conveyance or system of conveyances (including roads with drainage systems, municipal streets, catch basins, curbs, gutters, ditches, manmade channels, or storm drains) that is owned or operated by the Township of Brick or other public body, andis designed and used for collecting and conveying storm water.

NJPDES PERMIT - A permit issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to implement the New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) rules at N.J.A.C. 7:14A.

NONCONTACT COOLING WATER - Water used to reduce temperature for the purpose of cooling. Such waters do not come into direct contact with any rawmaterial, intermediate product (other than heat) or finished product. Noncontact cooling water may however contain algaecides or biocides to control fouling of equipment such as heat exchangers and/or corrosion inhibitors.

PROCESS WASTEWATER - Any water which, during manufacturing or processing, comes into direct contact with or results from the production or use of any raw material, intermediate product, finished product, by-product, or waste product. Process wastewater includes, but is not limited to, leachate and coolingwater other than noncontact cooling water.

STORMWATER -Water resulting from precipitation (including rain and snow) that runs off the land's surface, is transmitted to the subsurface, is captured by separate storm sewers or other sewerage or drainage facilities, or is conveyed by snow removal equipment.

§ 396-17. Prohibited conduct

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged through an illicit connection to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Township of Brick any domestic sewage, noncontact cooling water, process wastewater, or other industrial waste (other than stormwater).

§ 396-18. Enforcement

This article shall be enforced by the Police Department, Engineering Department, and/or the Land Use Department of the Township of Brick.

§ 396-19. Violations and penalties

Any person(s) who is found to be in violation of the provisions of this article shall be subject to the penalties as provided in Chapter I, § 1-15, General penalty.

ARTICLE III Private Storm Drain Inlet Retrofitting

§ 396-20. Purpose

The purpose of this article is to require the retrofitting of existing storm drain inlets which are in direct contact with repaving, repairing, reconstruction, resurfacing or alterations of facilities on private property, so as to prevent the discharge of solids and floatables (such as plastic bottles, cans, food wrappers and other litter) into the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the Township, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply.

§ 396-21. Definitions

As used in this article, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) — A conveyance or system of conveyances (including roads with drainage systems, municipal streets, catch basins, curbs, gutters, ditches, man-made channels, or storm drains) that is owned or operated by the Township of Brick or other public body, and is designed and used for collecting and conveying stormwater.

PERSON - Any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this state subject to municipal jurisdiction.

STORM DRAIN INLET - An opening in a storm drain used to collect stormwater runoff and includes, but is not limited to, a grate inlet, curb-opening inlet, slotted inlet, and combination inlet.

WATERS OF THE STATE - The ocean and its estuaries, all springs, streams and bodies of surface water or groundwater, whether natural or artificial, within the boundaries of the State of New Jersey or subject to its jurisdiction.

§ 396-22. Prohibited conduct

No person in control of private property (except a residential lot with one single- family house) shall authorize the repaving, repairing (excluding the repair of individual potholes), resurfacing (including top coating or chip sealing with asphalt emulsion or a thin base of hot bitumen), reconstructing or altering any surface that is in direct contact with an existing storm drain inlet on that property unless the storm drain inlet either:

- A. Already meets the design standard set forth in § 396-10 to control passage of solid and floatable materials; or
- B. Is retrofitted or replaced to meet the design standard in § 396-10 prior to the completion of the project. This standard does not apply:
 - (1) To a residential lot developed with a single-family home or duplex; or
 - (2) To the repair of potholes, restriping of paved areas or maintenance pavement sweeping or cleaning of drainage system.

§ 396-23. Design standard

Storm drain inlets identified in § 396-21 shall comply with the following standard to control passage of solid and floatable material through storm drain inlets. For purposes of this section, "solid and floatable materials" means sediment, debris, trash, and other floating, suspended, or settleable solids. Exemptions to this standard are set forth below.

A. Grates.

- (1) Design engineers shall use either of the following grates whenever they use a grate in pavement or another ground surface to collect stormwater from that surface into a storm drain or surface water body under that grate;
 - (a) The New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) bicycle safe grate, which is described in Chapter 2.4 of the NJDOT Bicycle Compatible Roadways and Bikeways Planning and Design Guidelines (April 1996); or
 - (b) A different grate, if each individual clear space in that grate has an area of no more than seven square inches, or is no greater than 0.5 inch across the smallest dimension.
- (2) Examples of grates subject to this standard include grates in grate inlets, the grate portion (non-curbopening portion) of combination inlets, grates on storm sewer manholes, ditch grates, trench grates, and grates of spacer bars in slotted drains. Examples of ground surfaces include surfaces of roads (including bridges), driveways, parking areas, bikeways, plazas, sidewalks, lawns, fields, open channels, and stormwater basin floors.
- B. Whenever design engineers use a curb-opening inlet, the clear space in that curb opening (or each individual clear space, if the curb opening has two or more clear spaces) shall have an area of no more than seven square inches, or be no greater than two inches across the smallest dimension.
- C. Exemptions. This standard does not apply:
 - (1)Where the Municipal Engineer agrees that this standard would cause inadequate hydraulic performance that could not practicably be overcome by using additional or larger storm drain inlets that meet these standards;
 - (2) Where flows are conveyed through any device (e.g., end-of-pipe netting facility, manufactured treatment device, or a catch basin hood) that is designed, at a minimum, to prevent delivery of all solid and floatable materials that could not pass through one of the following:
 - (a) A rectangular space 4 5/8 inches long and I 1/2 inches wide (this option does not apply for outfall netting facilities.); or
 - (b) A bar screen having a bar spacing of 0.5 inch.

- (3) Where flows are conveyed through a trash rack that has parallel bars with one-inch spacing between the bars; or
- (4) Where the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection determines, pursuant to the New Jersey Register of Historic Places Rules at N.J.A.C. 7:4-7.2(c), that action to meet this standard is an undertaking that constitutes an encroachment or will damage or destroy the New Jersey Register-listed historic property.

§ 396-24. Enforcement

This article shall be enforced by the Municipal Engineer of the Township of Brick.

§ 396-25. Violations and penalties

Any person(s) found to be in violation of the provisions of this article shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$500 for each storm drain inlet that is not retrofitted to meet the design standard.

ARTICLE IV Refuse Containers and Dumpsters

§ 396-26. Purpose

The purpose of this article is to require dumpsters and other refuse containers that are outdoors or exposed to stormwater to be covered at all times and to prohibit the spilling, dumping, leaking or otherwise discharge of liquids, semi-liquids or solids from the containers to the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the Township of Brick and/or the waters of the State, so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply.

§ 396-27. Definitions.

For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms, phrases, words, and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this Article clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not merely directory.

- A. MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) a conveyance or system of conveyances (including roads with drainage systems, municipal streets, catch basins, curbs, gutters, ditches, manmade channels, or storm drains) that is owned or operated by the Township of Brick or other public body, and is designed and used for collecting and conveying stormwater.
- B. PERSON any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction.
- C. REFUSE CONTAINER any waste container that a person controls, whether owned, leased, or operated, including dumpsters, trash cans, garbage pails, and plastic trash bags.
- D. STORMWATER means water resulting from precipitation (including rain and snow) that runs off

the land's surface, is transmitted to the subsurface, is captured by separate storm sewers or other sewerage or drainage facilities or is conveyed by snow removal equipment.

E. WATERS OF THE STATE – means the ocean and its estuaries, all springs, streams and bodies of surface or ground water, whether natural or artificial, within the boundaries of the State of New Jersey or subject to its jurisdiction.

§ 396-28. Prohibited conduct

- A. Any person who controls, whether owned, leased, or operated, a refuse container or dumpster, must ensure that such container or dumpster is covered at all times and shall prevent refuse from spilling out or overflowing.
- B. Any person who owns, leases or otherwise uses a refuse container or dumpster, must ensure that such container or dumpster does not leak or otherwise discharge liquids, semi-liquids or solids to the municipal separate storm sewer system(s) operated by the Township of Brick.

§ 396-29. Exceptions to prohibition

- A. Permitted temporary demolition containers.
- B. Litter receptacles (other than dumpsters or other bulk containers).
- C. Individual homeowner trash and recycling containers.
- D. Refuse containers at facilities authorized to discharge stormwater under a valid NJPDES permit.
- E. Large bulky items (e.g., furniture, bound carpet and padding, white goods placedcurbside for pickup).

§ 396-30. Enforcement.

This article shall be enforced by the Construction Code Official and/or the Municipal Engineer of the Township of Brick.

§ 396-31. Violations and penalties.

Any person(s) found to be in violation of the provisions of this article shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$100.00 per day, per offense.

ARTICLE V Improper Disposal of Waste

§ 396-32. Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to prohibit the spilling, dumping, or disposal of materials, other than stormwater, to the municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) operated by the Township of Brick so as to protect public health, safety and welfare, and to prescribe penalties for the failure to comply.

§ 396-33. Definitions.

For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms, phrases, words, and their derivations shall have the meanings stated herein unless their use in the text of this Article clearly demonstrates a different meaning. When not inconsistent with the context, words used in the present tense include the future, words used in the plural number include the singular number, and words used in the singular number include the plural number. The word "shall" is always mandatory and not

merely directory.

- a. Municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) a conveyance or system of conveyances (including roads with drainage systems, municipal streets, catch basins, curbs, gutters, ditches, manmade channels, or storm drains) that is owned or operated by the Township of Brick or other public body, and is designed and used for collecting and conveying stormwater.
- b. Person any individual, corporation, company, partnership, firm, association, or political subdivision of this State subject to municipal jurisdiction.
- c. Stormwater water resulting from precipitation (including rain and snow) that runs off the land's surface, is transmitted to the subsurface, is captured by separate storm sewers or other sewerage or drainage facilities or is conveyed by snow removal equipment.

§ 396-34. Prohibited Conduct:

The spilling, dumping, or disposal of materials, other than stormwater, to the municipal separate storm sewer system operated by the Township of Brick is prohibited. The spilling, dumping, or disposal of materials other than stormwater in such a manner as to cause the discharge of pollutants to the municipal separate storm sewer system is also prohibited.

§ 396-35. Exceptions to Prohibition.

- a. Water line flushing and discharges from potable water sources
- b. Uncontaminated ground water (e.g., infiltration, crawl space or basement sump pumps, foundation or footing drains, rising ground waters)
- c. Air conditioning condensate (excluding contact and non-contact cooling water)
- d. Irrigation water (including landscape and lawn watering runoff)
- e. Flows from springs, riparian habitats and wetlands, water reservoir discharges and diverted stream flows
- f. Residential car washing water, and residential swimming pool discharges
- g. Sidewalk, driveway and street wash water
- h. Flows from firefighting activities
- i. Flows from rinsing of the following equipment with clean water:
 - Beach maintenance equipment immediately following their use for their intended purposes; and
 - Equipment used in the application of salt and de-icing materials immediately following salt and de-icing material applications. Prior to rinsing with clean water, all residual salt and de-icing materials must be removed from equipmentand vehicles to the maximum extent practicable using dry cleaning methods (e.g., shoveling and sweeping). Recovered materials are to be returned to storage for reuse or properly discarded.

Rinsing of equipment, as noted in the above situation, is limited to exterior, undercarriage, and exposed parts and does not apply to engines or other enclosed machinery.

§ 396-36. Enforcement.

This ordinance shall be enforced by the Brick Township Police Department or the Code Enforcement Officer.

§ 396-37. Penalties.

Any person(s) who is found to be in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties as provided in Chapter 1, §1-15, General penalty.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
