WHEREAS, Dystonia Awareness Month will help provide a better understanding and compassion for those affected with one or more of the various forms of Dystonia and the impact the disorder has on those individuals and their families.

RESOLUTION LEAD GRANT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, effective July 22, 2022, the Legislature enacted P.L. 2021, c. 182, "An Act concerning certain lead-based paint hazard, and residential rental property, and establishing lead-based paint hazard programs, supplementing P.L. 2003, c. 311 (C. 52:27D-437.1 et al.) amending various parts of the statutory law, and making an appropriation;" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27D-437.16(b)(1), a municipality that maintains a permanent local agency for the purpose of conducting inspections and enforcing laws, ordinances, and regulations concerning buildings and structures, is required to inspect for lead-based paint hazards in certain specified single-family, two-family, and multiple rental dwellings, at the time periods set forth in the statute; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:27D-437.16(b)(2) a municipality that does not maintain such a permanent local agency must hire a lead evaluation contractor, certified to provide lead paint inspection services by DCA, or enter a shared services agreement as permitted by law, for the purpose of conducting the inspections for lead-based paint hazards; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 9 of P.L. 2021, c. 182, the State of New Jersey has allocated the sum of \$3,900,000 to effectuate the purposes of P.L. 2021, c. 182 (C. 52:27D-437.16). Further, pursuant to the FY 2023 Appropriations Act (P.L. 2022, Chapter 49), DCA received a grant-in-aid amount of \$3,900,000 for P.L. 2021, c. 182, for a total of \$7,800,000 in appropriations to effectuate the purpose of the Act.

WHEREAS, DCA has allocated \$7,000,000 of this appropriation to the development of the Lead Grant Assistance Program ("LGAP") for the issuance of grant funds to municipalities for the purpose of assisting in municipal compliance with P.L. 2021, c. 182.

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services (DLGS), within DCA, administers the LGAP; and

WHEREAS, the LGAP exists to provide funding to help off-set the costs to municipalities to provide the required inspections at stipulated times of certain single-family, two-family, and multiple rental dwelling units for lead-based paint hazards, pursuant to P.L. 2021, c. 182; and

WHEREAS, an authorized municipal officer must execute the attached grant agreement in order to receive LGAP funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Governing Body of the Township of Brick does hereby authorize Mayor Lisa Crate to sign the grant agreement, and thus bind the Township of Brick to the grant agreement's terms in order to receive the \$50,400.00 grant from the DLGS;

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH THE CRANFORD POLICE COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM (ID #47-CPCPS)

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4 requires that every contract for the provision of any goods or services, the cost of which in the aggregate exceeds the bid threshold, shall be awarded only by resolution of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, Brick Township residents and business owners in the community want to improve public safety and public order in their neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq., authorizes local units as defined in the Act to enter joint agreements for the provision of governmental services; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-5 requires that such an agreement be authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Township and community members want to reduce future criminal behavior related to mental illness, drug involvement, homelessness, poverty, and other health and wellness issues in the Township's communities; and

WHEREAS, arresting, booking, processing, and jailing individuals committing offenses related to mental illness, drug involvement, chronic homelessness, poverty, and other health and wellness issues in the Township has had limited effectiveness in improving either public safety or public order in the neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, interventions that connect individuals that have been charged with low level offenses with services may cost less and be more successful at reducing criminal behavior than processing these individuals through the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, a program grounded in harm reduction and housing first philosophies, such as the Law Enforcement Assisted Diverson Program (LEAD), may provide better results than traditional abstinence only programs; and

WHEREAS, numerous cities across the nation have launched their LEAD programs, and have shown that its collaborative, harm reduction approach to addressing and reducing crime and disorder has been successful.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. Brick Township agrees to participate in the LEAD Pilot Program, primarily through the involvement of the Brick Police Department and the County Prosecutor's Office. The Township shall also contribute representatives to the Policy Control Group and OWG as it deems necessary. The Township's participation shall be conducted in accordance with its LEAD Policy Document.
- 2. This MOU shall commence on the final date of signature by all parties and shall last for an initial term of one (1) year. This MOU shall automatically renew for one, one- year period at the expiration of the current term unless either party indicates its desire not to renew, so long as such written notification is provided to the other party at least ten (10) days prior to the expiration of the current term. Any Party may terminate this MOU for any reason and without cause upon five (5) calendardays notice to the other party.
- The Business Administrator is hereby authorized to execute and the Township Clerk to attest to a Memorandum of Understanding a copy of which is on file for public inspection in the Office of the Municipal Clerk.
- 4. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be provided by the Office of the Township Clerk to Chief of Police, Purchasing Agent, Business Administrator, Ocean County Sheriff's Office and the Ocean County Board of Commissioners.

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick is the owner of real property known as Block 842, Lot 14, 14.01 and 15, located at 1701 Route 88, (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS the Property is currently a vacant parcel of property; and

WHEREAS the Township of Brick proposes to convey the property to Homes Now, Inc., or an entity to be formed by Homes Now Inc. for the purpose of developing the property for affordable rental housing for low or moderate income individuals; and

WHEREAS the property will remain subject to a deed restriction limiting the use of the property under the Uniform Housing Affordability Controls found in the New Jersey Administrative Code at Title 5 chapter 80, subchapter 26 (N.J.A.C. 5:80-26.1, et seq., the "Uniform Controls") for affordable housing for a period of fifty (50) years; and

WHEREAS the property will remain subject to a deed restriction providing the Township of Brick with a right of first-refusal on any sale during the control period and the option to purchase the property at the expiration of the control period at the maximum allowed restricted sale price at the time;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Township is the owner of real property known as Block 842, Lots 14, 14.01 and 15, located at 1701 Route 88.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and Township Council declare the Property to be surplus and not needed for public use.

SECTION 3. The Mayor and Township Council have determined it to be in the public interest to sell the Property by private sale pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-21 to Home Now Inc., or an entity to be formed by Homes Now Inc., for the development of the property for rental housing of individuals with low or moderate income.

SECTION 4. The sale of the Property is subject to the terms, conditions, restrictions, and limitations which shall specifically include a condition to record a deed restriction. The deed restriction shall restrict the use of the property to the development or rental housing for low- or moderate-income individuals for a period of fifty (50) years from the date of sale under the Uniform Housing Affordability Controls found in the New Jersey Administrative Code at Title 5 chapter 80, subchapter 26 (N.J.A.C. 5:80-26.1, et seq., the "Uniform Controls"). The property shall be further restricted to provide the Township of Brick with a right of first refusal on any sale during the control period and an option to purchase the property at the expiration of the control period at the maximum allowed restricted sale price at that time.

SECTION 5. The closing on the sale of the property shall occur upon Homes Now, Inc., obtaining all necessary approvals to develop the property in accordance with the terms of this Ordinance. Homes Now Inc. shall have a period of two years from adoption of this Ordinance to close on the sale of the property.

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
