ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK IN SECTION 110-18 TO ESTABLISH A DAILY PARKING DISCOUNT FOR SENIORS AT THE OCEAN BEACHES PARKING LOTS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 110 of the Township Code of the Township of Brick entitled "Beaches and Waterfront Areas" is hereby amended in Section 110-18 to establish a daily parking discount for seniors, and to eliminate the seasonal parking discount for seniors, with the amended portions to read as follows:

§ 110-18 Fees.

J. Senior citizen daily parking discount.

A senior citizen, age 65 or older, that wishes to obtain a daily parking discount authorizing parking of a motor vehicle in areas provided for that purpose shall pay \$1 each day, upon providing proof of his/her age with photo identification at the time of arrival.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
