#### **ORDINANCE**

CALENDAR YEAR 2024 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14)

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council of the Township of Brick in the County of Ocean finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2024 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township Council hereby determines that a 3.5 % increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$3,220,611.87 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS the Township Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Township Council of the Township of Brick, in the County of Ocean, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2024 budget year, the final appropriations of the Township of Brick shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 1.0%, bringing the percentage to 3.5% amounting to a \$920,174.82 increase, bringing the total to \$3,220,611.87 and that the CY 2024 municipal budget for the Township of Brick be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

### RESOLUTION CLOSE OUT CHANGE ORDER #1

WHEREAS, the Township of Brick previously awarded a contract to Earle Asphalt Company, P.O. Box 556, Farmingdale, NJ 07727 on February 14, 2023 for the project known as "Roadway Improvements to Laurelhurst – Phase III" for a total contract price in the amount of \$557,613.13; and

WHEREAS, Earle Asphalt Company has completed the project; and

WHEREAS, the Consulting Engineer, CME Associates, has inspected the work and deemed the work to be complete; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-11.3 the Consulting Engineer has recommended the approval of Close-Out Change Order #1 decreasing the contract by \$364.67 from \$557,613.13 to \$557,248.46 as a result of final as-built quantities; and

WHEREAS, the approval of this Close-Out Change Order #1 will result in the return of the performance bond posted for this project. Contractor has provided maintenance bond, which will run for a period of two (2) years; and

WHEREAS, the Township Attorney has reviewed the maintenance bond and deemed same to be acceptable; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now the desire of this Township Council to act upon the Consulting Engineer's recommendation and to approve said Close-Out Change Order #1.

WHEREAS, there is not any beach replenishment planned before the 2024 summer season, which means that there will be significantly less space available on the beaches; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council desire to provide space on the beaches for the maximum number of beachgoers to enjoy the beach this summer; and

WHEREAS, canopies and tents will take up too much of the limited space available; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to amend its beach rules and regulations to prohibit canopies and tents for the 2024 summer season.



D. Nonprofit theater consumption license pursuant to and meeting the conditions of N.J.S.A. 33:1-19.8 for a nonprofit corporation with a premises with a seating capacity of 50 persons or more but less than 1,000 persons that is primarily used to conduct musical or theatrical performances or concerts.

**SECTION 2.** Chapter 86 of the Township Code of the Township of Brick entitled "Alcoholic Beverages" is hereby amended in Section 86-6 to add a new subsection I, which shall read as follows:

§ 86-6 Fees.

\*\*\*

I. The annual license fee for a Nonprofit Theater Consumption License shall be \$250.
