**WHEREAS**, the HGAC-Buy awarded contract #EC07-23 entitled "9-1-1 Equipment & Emergency Notification Software & Services" to Comtech Solacom Technologies, Inc., 80 Jean Proulx, Gatineau, Quebec, J8Z 1W1; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Deputy Chief of Police and Director of Information Technology to upgrade the Township's current 911 call system as listed in the quotation dated June 20, 2024, through the HGAC-Buy contract #EC07-23; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township is in receipt of the requisite documentation in order to award this contract through the cooperative purchasing agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the availability of funds for said purchase to be awarded herein has been certified by the Chief Financial Officer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY**, as follows:
