ORDINANCE

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BRICK, COUNTY OF OCEAN,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 288 OF
THE TOWNSHIP CODE, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" TO ADD A NEW
SECTION TO REGULATE LOW-SPEED ELECTRIC BICYCLES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of Brick, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Township hereby amends Chapter 288 of the Township Code to add a new Article IX, to be entitled "Low-Speed Electric Bicycles," and which shall read as follows:

Article IX. Low-Speed Electric Bicycles.

§ 288-76. Definitions.

As used in this Section, the following terms, consistent with N.J.S.A. 39:1-1, shall have the definitions indicated:

Low-Speed Electric Bicycle

A two- or three-wheeled vehicle with fully operable pedals and an electric motor of less than 750 watts that meets the requirements of one of the following classifications: "class 1 low-speed electric bicycle," which means a low-speed electric bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling, and that ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of 20 miles per hour; or "class 2 low-speed electric bicycle," which means a low-speed electric bicycle equipped with a motor that may be used exclusively to propel the bicycle, and that is not capable of providing assistance when the bicycle reaches the speed of 20 miles per hour.

Motorized Bicycle

A pedal bicycle having a helper motor characterized in that either the maximum piston displacement is less than 50 cc. or said motor is rated at no more than 1.5 brake horsepower or is powered by an electric drive motor and said bicycle is capable of a maximum speed of no more than 25 miles per hour on a flat surface or a pedal bicycle having an electric motor that is capable of propelling the bicycle in excess of 20 miles per hour with a maximum motor-powered speed of no more than 28 miles per hour on a flat surface. This term shall not include a Low-Speed Electric Bicycle.

§ 288-77. Operation of Low-Speed Electric Bicycles within the Township

A. Duties of persons on low-speed electric bicycles.

Any person operating a low-speed electric bicycle shall obey the instructions of official traffic control signals, signs, and other control devices applicable to vehicles, unless otherwise directed by a police officer. Operators of a low-speed electric bicycle shall ride as near to the right-side of the traveled roadway as practicable, exercising due care when passing a standing vehicle or one proceeding in the same direction.

B. Lights and reflectors.

Every low-speed electric bicycle shall have reflectors in the front and back. Every low-speed electric bicycle shall, when in use at nighttime, be equipped with a lamp on the front which shall emit a white light visible from a distance of at least 500 feet to the front, and with a lamp on the rear which shall emit a red light visible from a distance of at least 500 feet to the rear.

C. Audible sound/signal.

No person shall operate a low-speed electric bicycle unless it is equipped with a bell or other device capable of giving a signal audible for a distance of at least 100 feet, except that such low-speed electric bicycles shall not be equipped with, nor shall any person use upon a low-speed electric bicycle any siren or whistle.

D. Helmet.

All persons under the age of 17 are required to wear a protective helmet while operating a low-speed electric bicycle.

E. Riding on sidewalks and walking paths.

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No person over the age of 14 shall operate a low-speed electric bicycle upon a sidewalk within the Township of Brick, nor in any location prohibited by signage.

F. Reckless or careless riding.

No person shall ride or operate a low-speed electric bicycle in a reckless or careless manner which endangers or is likely to endanger the safety or welfare of themselves or other persons or property. No person operating a low-speed electric bicycle shall attach themselves to any streetcar or vehicle, nor shall the operator of the low-speed electric bicycle allow others to hitch or hold onto an electric bicycle during operation. It shall be prohibited for a person operating a low-speed electric bicycle to allow another person to ride as a passenger, unless the person is carried in a proper seat, trailer or other accessory that complies with current regulations and contains adequate provision for retaining the passenger in place and for protecting the passenger.

G. Prohibited Locations.

Low-speed electric bicycles are prohibited from operating within or upon any Township-owned properties or recreation areas, including but not limited to Windward Beach, Lake Riviera Park, Bernard J Cooke Park, Drum Point Sports Complex, Herbertsville Park, Joe Boland Field, Pinewood Acres Complex, Hank Waltonowski Park, Frede Drive Park, VFW Park, Arrowhead Park, Mallard Point Park, Bay Harbor Beach, Edmund Hibbard Park, Angela Hibbard Park, Bayside Park, Traders Cove Marina and Park, Sawmill Trail, Airport Trail, and Haven's Farm. Those who have obtained a permit for use of a Township-owned park or recreational area for a special event where the use of such vehicles is specifically authorized shall be exempt from the prohibitions in this paragraph.

H. Exempt Vehicles. This Section shall not apply to those devices used to increase the independent mobility of an individual who has limited or no ambulation abilities, such as a motorized wheelchair. This Section also shall not apply to toy electric vehicles, such as power wheels, designed for toddlers, where the maximum speed is less than 3MPH.

I. Penalties for Violations.

Each person violating any provisions of this section shall, upon first conviction, be liable to a penalty of \$50.00, and upon a second conviction shall be liable to a penalty of \$100.00. No court appearance shall be required for a first or second alleged offense but will be required for a third or subsequent alleged offense.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication in an official newspaper of the Township, as required by law.
